Alresford War Memorial. Ford Lane off B1027 S of railway by 0.5 mile. Head back N beyond level crossing to take Cockaynes Lane left. At its right bend, go left and sweep right on path which leads to Cockaynes Wood. When gravel extraction begin the paths will loop N. Otherwise straight though the woodland and out midfield to a continue on a gravel track which dips to Sixpenny Brook. Hint lagoon on right. Step down stream left, water on right, through to quarry track. Go left to gate and right outside fence to stiled level crossing of railway. S to Wivenhoe Road, right on greensward to bend junction with Cut Throat Lane. Select the minor track, the quarry road parallel. Pursue the Lane until beyond Alresford Grange Wood, then take woodside path down right to get Colneside. Resume S on Abounding Essex Edge route, to enter Alresford Creek, pass the fording place, and regain the seawall all the way to Sixpenny Brook's outfall. Turn inland to use a path W of Plumpton Farm and S of a tree stand. Continue W by a pitscape and join Ford Lane going uphill right. Final flourish: bear left on other end of Cut Throat Lane, and where lane bifurcates to minor track and lorry road, go sharp right down betwix anglers' pitscapes, over Sixpenny Brook and up to Alresford Church burnt in 1971.
