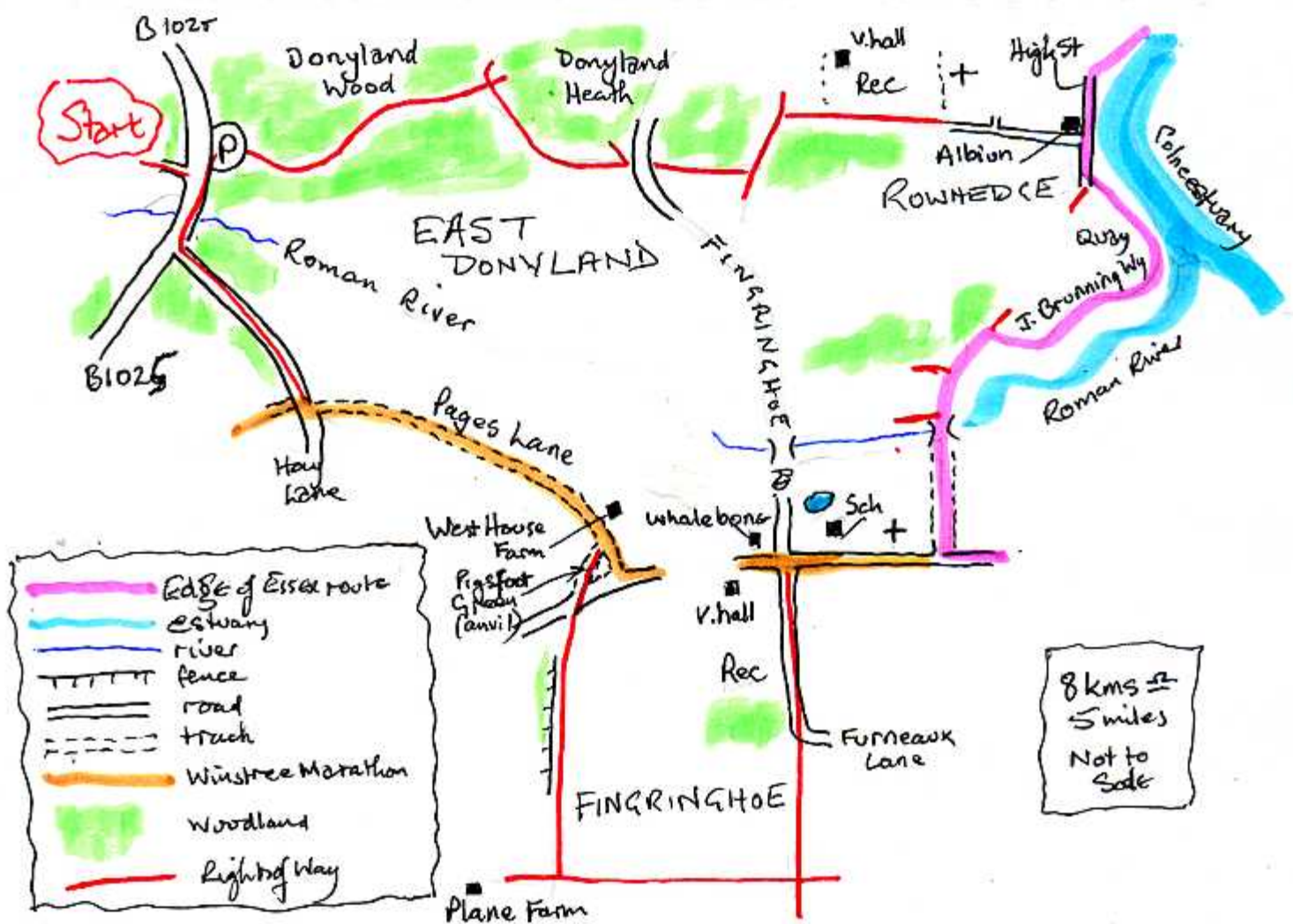

East Donyland, Wood layby B1025 above Manwood Bridge. The woodland's bridleway sports a flagpole. If it is naked; walk on. If a red flag is hoisted, avoid disappointment by switching to the West Donyland Walk given with this batch of routes.

Pursue the bridleway through the lovely woodland up to Donyland Heath, also wooded. Select the footpath right which threads through to the SW corner and swings left by the arable edge to cross Fingringhoe Road or to the opposite path. Wind through Rowhedge's Recreation Ground to exit by Parkfield's gate and descend Albion Street to High Street. At the southern end of which two footpaths emanate. Select the left one and carefully follow painted instructions across the quay to mount the seawall by the Roman River's confluence with the Colne. Trace John Brunning Way to Fingringhoe Mill and rise to Church level via the drive. Pass St Andrew's and turn left at The Whalebone, to continue southward off Furneaux Lane's bend on a track offering extensive views. Bear right at the crosstracks and take the next right before Plane Farm to arrive at Pigsfoot Green triangle with an anvil. Use Page Lane passing West House Farm, to reach Hay Lane. dip down right on the footwayless road to emerge on the B1025. Right along the verge beside snarling traffic, is the layby. **TM 011 206 East**
