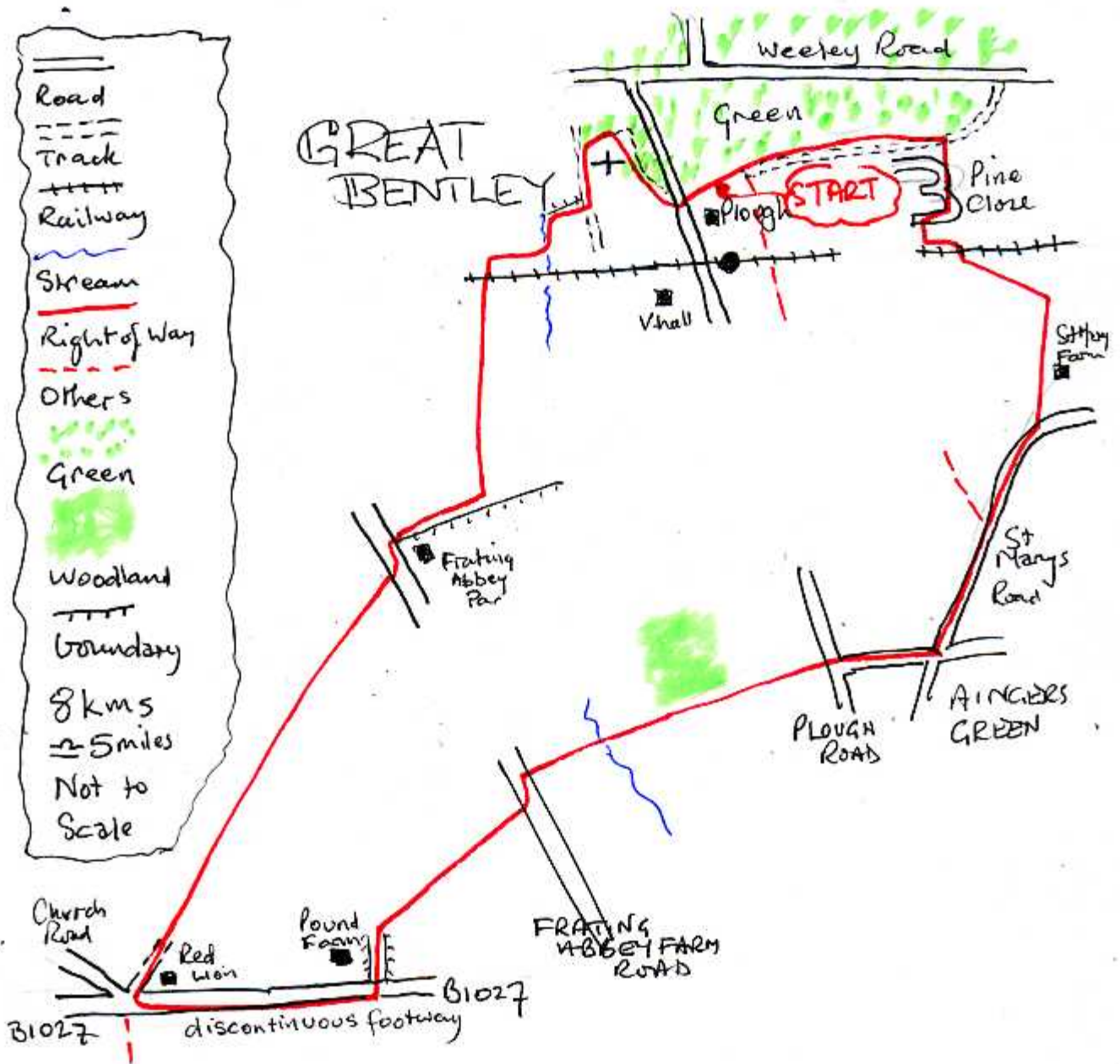


Colchester Ramblers' Association Group Ramble Available for Leading culled from

Great Bentley Green near the Plough off A133 or B1029. Skirt the southern edge of The Green going E until nearly converged with Weeley Road. An urban path leads right to Pine Close. Chase it to get closer to the rail ganties. The path resumes beside 15/16 and doubles left behind the garden to a level crossing. Head S for St Marys Farm via the footbridge, and walk the lane to Angiers Green, going right at the crossroads and straight over at the T junction. Fieldpaths ensue to a staggered crossing of Frating Abbey Road, then midfield to the garden fencing and betwix gardens to B1027. Lead right by the better grassy verge and go right again at The Red Lion. A lane becomes a path to Frating Abbey. Go left then right on a headland, looking to spurt left to a stiled crossing of the railway. Right by the fence, over the stream, rise towards the Church, use track to pass W of it and emerge on Great Bentley Green TM 111 216
