Wivenhoe, Rosabelle Avenue carpark in Woods off B1028. Leave carpark S under woodland canopy and gradually converge with railtrack. Use it to steer to a B1028 crossing beside The Greyhound. Stride Queens Road to go uphill left from the T junction on unmetalled Anglesey Road becoming Ballast Quay Road. Fork right on permissive path, fence on right, to cross Alresford Road and enter the gravel road continuation. Notice the dip of Sixpenny Brook and the lagoon left side to turn right, down steps to have brook rightside. Pursue to quarry road, go left and right at the gate as fence steers to stiled crossing of railway. Continue S to Wivenhoe Road. Use greensward around right and bend right to railbridge. A stile SW of it, gives egress to charming path to Colne water's edge. Right to wend through Wivenhoe as close to waterfront as possible and emerge on earthen bank opposite Roman river confluence. Confronted by Rowhedge's Anchor Inn, turn right on permissive path across marsh reserve to the railtrack. Bend right on cycle path, left through tunnel to Woods. Retrace steps, gradually diverging from railway when climbing to carpark. **TM 033 224**
